About the Department

- The Department of Nursing, affiliated with the Faculty of Health Sciences, began admitting students in the 2018–2019 academic year.
- The duration of the nursing program is four years, and the language of instruction is Turkish.
- Upon completing their undergraduate education, nursing students graduate with the title of “Nurse”.

Education in Our Department

- Nursing education consists of theoretical and professional practice courses.
- Starting from the second semester of the first year, in every semester, practical training is carried out first in the professional skills laboratory and then in the relevant hospital clinics and educational institutions, together with the instructors.

Aims of the Nursing Program

Program Aims (PA):

P.A.1: Our graduates are employed as nurses in preventive, curative and rehabilitative fields, where they can meet the health care needs of healthy/ill individuals, families and society in line with the nursing process.

Performance Indicator:

- 70% of our graduates are employed within the first five years.

Aims of the Nursing Program

P.A.2: Our graduates practice their profession in line with the professional roles and competencies defined at national and international levels.

Performance Indicator:

Managers' professional evaluations of the nursing care provided by our graduates are at least 70 out of 100.

Aims of the Nursing Program

P.A.3: Our graduates continue their professional development after graduation with an awareness of lifelong learning.

Performance Indicator:

- 10% of our graduates continue with professional certificate programs and/or graduate education within the first five years.

3. Provides nursing care on an evidence-based basis, in line with the nursing process.

Prerequisite Courses – 2

To be able to take the fourth-year fall and spring courses M3_HEM401 Nursing Care Practices I and M3_HEM402 Nursing Care Practices II, students must have taken and passed the following courses:

Course Attendance in Our Department

- Attendance at classes and practical training is **compulsory**.
- A student who does not attend **70%** of the **theoretical** hours and **80%** of the **practical** hours of a course **cannot take the end-of-semester exam of that course.**

Course Assessment

- Professional practice courses – **Absolute Evaluation**
- Common compulsory and theory-only courses – **Relative Evaluation**

Students whose raw score at the end of the semester is **below 50**, and students whose success grade from the midterm and final exams is **below 40** (FF), fail the course.

Information on Academic Advising

Scope of the academic advising service:

- Career guidance
- Providing information about courses
- Supporting personal development
- Directing students to social activities to support personal development
- Guidance for establishing contact with sector representatives
- Suggesting fields of specialization according to the student's interests
- Organizing joint academic, social responsibility and art activities

It is important that you meet with your academic advisor **at least once a month** throughout the semester.

Academic Advising Workflow

1. At the beginning of each academic year, academic advisors are determined by the Department Board decision and announced on the department website.
2. Advisors hold at least one meeting with their students at the beginning and end of each semester and prepare a report.
3. At the beginning of the semester, advisors post their advising hours on their office doors.
4. For individual meetings, the student makes an appointment via institutional e-mail/UBYS message/office phone; the meeting is recorded on the Academic Advising Individual Meeting Form.
5. During the semester, advisors follow their students' academic progress. They plan meetings with students whose midterm grade in professional practice courses is below 50 and/or whose absenteeism exceeds 50%, filling in the Nursing Department Student Early Warning Form and the Individual Meeting Form.
6. At the end of each academic year, advisors submit their reports to the Continuous Improvement Commission and the Standard 3.7 Working Group.

Peer Mentoring

- The peer mentoring program was created to facilitate and organize the adaptation of Nursing Department students to university life.
- Third- and fourth-year students (mentors) provide mentoring to first- and second-year students (mentees): 4th-year students mentor 1st-year students, and 3rd-year students mentor 2nd-year students.
- The program's structure, working principles, duties, authorities and responsibilities are defined in the Peer Mentoring Program Guide, prepared by the Nursing Department Board decision.
- Mentors and mentees sign a Student Matching Form, agreeing to attend planned meetings, stay in contact at least twice a month (face-to-face, e-mail or phone), respect confidentiality and privacy, answer questions honestly, remain open to feedback, and adhere to ethical principles and professional values.

Peer Mentoring (continued)

- At the end of the program, mentors fill in the Peer Mentoring Mentor Process Evaluation Form, and mentees fill in the Mentee Process Evaluation Form.
- The forms evaluate items such as: ease of communication, support with difficult courses, gaining self-confidence, development of communication and problem-solving skills, social support with city life and club memberships, and feeling more comfortable before clinical practice.

Social Transcript

- The Social Transcript records the gains that students obtain from extracurricular activities during their studies, in accordance with the İzmir Bakırçay University Associate and Undergraduate Social Transcript Implementation Directive.
- Covered areas: social responsibility and community service, scientific events, clubs and organizations, degrees and awards, culture-arts and sports, entrepreneurship and innovation.
- Examples of recognized activities: preparing or taking part in a social responsibility project, volunteering in NGOs, organizing or attending congresses/conferences/symposia, presenting papers, publishing in refereed journals, developing or competing with scientific projects, founding or leading a student club, taking active roles in club events, participating in art activities or sports competitions, holding a refereeing or active athlete license.
- Applications are evaluated and approved by the Evaluation Commission formed in the departments.
